Educator Supported Bills

Assembly Bills

AB 331 (Medina): Ethnic Studies Graduation Requirement. Adds the completion of an ethnic studies course to the requirements for high school graduation.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY: (63-17) 05/23/19 SENATE: (33-7) 08/31/20

AB 376 (Stone): Student Borrower Bill of Rights. Creates a comprehensive set of rights for people holding student debt and giving borrowers the right to hold these student loan companies accountable when they fail to meet basic servicing standards.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY: (59-21) 05/28/19 SENATE (29-11) 08/28/20

AB 841 (Ting): Energy Efficiency Programs. Creates a program to make the air and drink water safer in public schools, while reducing energy bills, and accelerating infrastructure for zero-emission vehicles.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (55-24) 08/31/20 SENATE (25-15) 08/31/20

AB 897 (Medina): Increase CCC Part-time Faculty Hours Threshold. Changes the percentage of hours a part-time temporary employee may teach up to 85% of the hours per week a full-time employee having comparable duties.

HELD IN SENATE

ASSEMBLY: (76-4) 01/27/20

AB 1350 (Gonzalez): Pandemic High School Diplomas Requirements. Allows high school seniors on track to graduate but unable to complete diploma requirements due to COVID-19 related closures to receive a diploma.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (75-4) 08/30/20 SENATE (39-1) 08/28/20

AB 1963 (Chu): Minor Employee Mandated Reporter Requirements.

Updates the mandated reporting requirements for employers of minors including a list of mandated reporters and additional training requirements.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (76-3) 06/08/20 SENATE (39-1) 08/28/20

AB 1982 (Cunningham): Exceptions to the Basic Skills Proficiency Test.

Exempts applicants who have earned at least a letter grade of B in qualifying coursework from the basic skills proficiency test requirement.

HELD IN SENATE

ASSEMBLY: (75-4) 06/10/20

AB 2112 (Ramos): Suicide Prevention. Creates the Office of Suicide Prevention to help address the crisis of suicide by coordinating state resources by devoting resources to studying this crisis and make recommendations to the legislature.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY: (78-1) 06/10/20 SENATE (39-1) 08/30/20

AB 2234 (Chau): Personnel Commission Conflict of Interest. Allows school personnel commissioners to have a role in determining if a conflict of interest exists between the personnel commission and the local school board, entitling them to independent legal counsel.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (77-2) 06/08/20 SENATE (39-1) 08/28/20

AB 2485 (Kalra): Teacher Credentialing Subject Matter Competence.

Authorizes candidates for the preliminary multiple or single subject teaching credential to show subject matter competence by completing higher education coursework in the subject of the content area of the credential.

ASSEMBLY: (78-1) 06/10/20

AB 3308 (Gabriel): School District Employee Housing. Clarifies that state policy allows school districts to open occupancy of affordable housing to school district employees first, if the school district owns the land.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (71-8) 06/10/20 SENATE (35-5) 08/30/20

Senate Bills

SB 275 (Pan): Health Care Essential Workers. Require healthcare providers and the state to have a stockpile of personal protective equipment (PPE) for use by Healthcare and Essential workers during an emergency.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (66-13) 08/31/20 SENATE (31-9) 08/31/20

SB 860 (Beall): Foster Youth Services Coordinating Program.

Improves coordination to support foster youth with completing FAFSA forms and ensures they have access to critical financial support to succeed in college.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (75-4) 08/30/20 SENATE (39-1) 06/11/20

SB 884 (Dodd): Emergencies Power Shutoffs. Adds public safety power shutoffs to the list of emergencies for which a school district or county office of education may be credited for purposes of average daily attendance.

HELD IN ASSEMBLY

SENATE (39-1) 06/24/2020

SB 1159 (Hill): Workers' Compensation Presumption. Creates a workers' compensation rebuttable presumption for some workers who contract COVID-19 at work.

SIGNED INTO LAW

ASSEMBLY (69-10) 08/31/20 SENATE (28-12) 06/26/20
